Closed Campus: Based on recommendations by the Ventura County Office of Education in consultation with the County Public Health Officer, we will maintain a closed campus through the end of this school year. We will continue to provide a quality distance-learning program, and we will be continuing to monitor the situation as we plan graduations and end-of-the-year celebrations for a later date.

Science Fair: Even though we are not being able to come back to school physically amidst this pandemic, we are happy to announce that we are still going forward with the science fair projects. They will be displayed to the community in an online format, and the guidelines will be changed slightly to

accommodate our stay-at-home orders. Each teacher will provide his/her class with more information.
