**Adjusted Tuition Schedule:** We are adjusting our payment schedule for next year. The first payment will be due on or before the first day of school, with the following payments being due on the first of the month. The tenth and final payment will be due on May 1, rather than June 1.

**Enrollment Discount:** To receive the \$50 early enrollment discount, both the registration and curriculum fees need be paid on or before Friday, July 17. The complete re-enrollment process can be done online; of course, you are also welcome to come in and do it in the office.
